

Student Bus Behaviour Code

Students are expected to adhere to the Bus Behaviour Code. Let us work together to keep everyone safe and happy, on the journey to and from school. Parents are encouraged to discuss the following standards with their child at home.

Do's:

- Travel by your designated school bus.
- Be on time for pick-up and departure.
- Make sure the road is safe before crossing the street.
- Always cross the road while being accompanied by the Bus Guardian or nominated guardian.
- Stay at least 10 steps away from the school bus and make sure the Bus Driver can see you.
- Avoid the danger zone areas surrounding the bus.
- Scan your RFID card when boarding and getting off the bus.
- Sit in the designated bus seat as advised by the Bus Guardian.
- Wear a seat belt for every journey.
- Remain seated until advised by the Bus Guardian.
- Always face forward when seated.
- Keep the aisles and walkway clear at all times.
- Be courteous and follow the Bus Guardian and Bus Driver's instructions.
- Use electronic devices responsibly and report any misuse to your Bus Guardian or Bus Driver.
- Ensure to take any personal items when leaving the bus.

Don'ts:

- Stand while the school bus is moving.
- Sit on a restricted seat.
- Distract the Bus Driver.
- Shout or be disrespectful towards others.
- Bring friends onto the bus without written permission from STS and the school.
- Eat or drink (except water) on the bus.
- Throw objects of any kind in the bus.
- Place anything on the windows of the bus.
- Damage the bus in any way. Repair costs for any damage will be charged back to the student.
